# SUMMER ART STUDIO 2009

This exciting program is carefully designed with promises for three hours each day, with a refreshment break halfway through each daily session.

Summer Art Studio will be held in the Studio Annex Building of River Oaks Square Arts Center. Participants may arrive as early as 12:30 p.m. and pick up will be through 5:30 p.m.

All projects incorporate a variety of different media, and while most will offer specific products, students will all become well acquainted with basic ceramic procedures (pinch, coil, slab), basic painting protocol, and other projects which will introduce them to a variety of unique materials.

To assist working parents, River Oaks is offering an all-day option to children participating in the SAS workshop. The all-day option will provide lunch to each child and extra projects (including movies, games, and additional art instruction) during the morning hours. Drop off time is 7:30 a.m. and pickup is between 4:30p.m. - 5:30 p.m.

## WHO WE ARE

River Oaks Square is a contemporary visual arts and crafts center made up of resident artists working with a variety of media. The center is housed in two facilities, the historic Bolton Home and the Studio Annex Building, and visitors are encouraged to browse through the studios and watch the artists at work.

River Oaks also hosts over 20 exhibits annually, which feature works of local, regional and resident artists. Art classes are available on site for both adults and children. River Oaks is a non-profit organization governed by a volunteer Board of Directors and a professional staff. It is supported by membership dues, corporate donations, grants through the City of Alexandria, Louisiana Division of the Arts, National Endowment for the Arts and local foundations.

### Summer Art Studio

#### SESSION #1 June 1-12, 2009

### Summer Art Studio

This entire session is entitled "All About Me." Students will work on self portraits, many, many self portraits. River Oaks will extend our Summer Art Studio to incorporate the old Artworks Program at River Oaks instead of Louisiana College. We will also concentrate exclusively on visual art as this is what we do best. Our ceramics and painting studios are as modern and well equipped as any in Louisiana. Our instructors were chosen based on their history of successful projects and programs working with children at River Oaks. We are certainly excited about the upcoming summer sessions and hope you choose to send your children here for one or more of our summer camps.

A note about our consolidation of Summer Art Studio and our ArtWorks Program at Louisiana College. The ARTWORKS Program has been around for over 20 years, and River Oaks is pleased to have worked such a great partner as Louisiana College to present this program. ARTWORKS evolved out of a need for a multidisciplinary arts based summer program which had not previously existed. Obviously a lot of things change over the course of 20 years, and one of the fortunate changes for Central Louisiana has been the development of exciting new dance, acting, and music programs for children to attend during the summer months. With this in mind River Oaks has decided to focus on a program moving closer to our mission of providing quality visual arts education to our community.
